The Chesterton Art Center, operated by the Association of Artists and Craftsmen of Porter County, is proud to sponsor **ART COMP 2010**, a biennial juried competition. The purpose of this exhibition: 1) to strengthen the development of individual artists, and 2) to stimulate and expand the audience for arts in the region.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Competition is open to all artists over 18 years old residing in Indiana, Illinois, and Michigan.

Work must be original in concept and execution, created within the past two years, not completed under instruction, and not previously exhibited at the Chesterton Art Center. No copies or prints of paintings, published photographs or other artist's work will be accepted. No wet paintings.

All work that will hang on the wall must be fitted with wire. No sawtoothed hangers. Sculpture must have an adequate base. Graphic work must be matted with light or neutral mats.

Maximum size for two dimensional work is 5 feet in any direction. Three dimensional work must not weigh more than 100 pounds.

All entries must be ready for installation and must not require the artist's presence for handling.

JURORS

Bonnie Zimmer, chairman of the Art Department. at St. Joseph's College in Rensselaer, has received four Indiana Arts Commission Individual Artists' Grants. Her most recent grant funded 'Orbs' a collaborative sculpture project located on the grounds of the Indianapolis Art Center. Zimmer has exhibited widely including the Indiana State Museum, and the Lafayette Museum of Art.

Dana Zier is also an instructor at St. Joseph's College. She teaches drawing, painting and print-making. She works in oils and mixed media. Her work is exhibited widely and has won many awards including Best of Show at the Lubeznik Center's 2009 *Prints and Drawing: Works on Paper*.

OPENING RECEPTION

All entering artists are invited to attend and bring guests to the opening reception, Sunday, August 29, from 2 pm to 4 pm. Over \$2,500 in awards will be presented. Best of Show Award will be \$700.

ENTRY FEES

A nonrefundable entry fee of \$25 for Chesterton Art Center member artists, and \$30 for nonmembers entitles each artist to submit one or two entries. Make checks payable to the **Chesterton Art Center**.

DELIVERY AND RETURN OF ENTRIES

Hand-deliver entries to the Chesterton Art Center from July 25 to August 13. The hours at the Art Center are weekdays 11 am - 4 pm and weekends 1 pm - 4 pm.

All works not selected for the exhibit must be picked up August 18 - 28. All work selected for the exhibit must be picked up September 26- 30.

SALES AND INSURANCE

The Chesterton Art Center will retain 20% on members sales and 30% on nonmember sales. All works must be for sale. All accepted artwork will be insured for the duration of the exhibit. A maximum insurance of \$5,000 per work is allowed.

LIABILITY

The AACPC will not be responsible for damage to artwork left after October 1, 2010. After 90 days the work is considered abandoned property.
