# Youth Art Classes

### Afterschool Art Classes



Afterschool Art Classes are offered every month from September-May for ages 5-16. During each 4-class monthly session, students will explore an arts-related theme, topic, or movement through a wide variety of 2D media such as watercolor, pastel, graphite, acrylic, or printmaking. Because each monthly session offers a different theme and set of projects, families are welcomed to register for one session, a few, or the whole year!

Tuition for this prorated

2-week session is \$45 for non-members and \$35 for current CAC Family Members. All supplies provided.

The December sessions of Afterschool Art will focus on the Fauvism Art Movement, and are instructed by Jen Aitchison. Artists like Matisse and Derain loved to use color in unexpected and exciting ways. Students will push the boundaries of color during this month as they create colorful snow paintings that are sure to bring happiness and joy.

## **Preschool Pop-In Classes**

Preschool Pop-Ins are offered on the 2nd Tuesday of each month at 10-11:30 AM and are recommended for ages 3-5. Young artists will focus on the development of fine motor skills through creative arts learning experiences. Each class will focus on a unique theme that highlights color, shape, cutting, building, or painting. Parents and/or caregivers are encouraged to stay & create together with their young artist.

Because each monthly session offers a different theme and special project, families are welcomed to register for one session, a few, or the whole year!

Tuition for each 1-class session is \$30 for non-members and \$20 for current CAC Family Members. All supplies provided.

The December Preschool Pop-In session meets on Tuesday, December 13 at 10-11:30 AM and is recommended for ages 3-5.

This month's Pop-In will focus on color! Students will share discussions of colors they see in the snow, pulling inspiration from the colorful Fauvism Art Movement. They will create a colorful winter wonderland piece to celebrate the changing season.

In January, students will pull inspiration from Surrealism as they create an imaginative mixed-media art piece.




## Additional Youth Programming

#### **Introduction to Animation**

This 5-week class will meet from Saturday, January 14-February 11 at 10 AM-12 PM and is for ages 12 to 18.

With guidance from Katie Wiley, this beginner-friendly class will take students through a quick history of animation and teach using traditional 2-D techniques the way the pros have been working for years! Artists can expect to learn about the 12 principles of animation and use them to complete a new animation "challenge" each week. Parents and/ or caregivers are invited to attend the last class for a final showcase of the class animation 'reel'.

#### Advanced Digital Photography Workshop with Deb Armstrong

This 1-day workshop will meet on Saturday, December 3 at 10 AM-1 PM.

Are you ready to take your digital photography skills to the next level? With instruction from Deb Armstrong, students will advance their introductory photo skills from basic snapshots to striking images. This workshop will review photo composition, digital photography techniques, and additional tips and tricks to help students become a master behind the camera lens. Students will also discuss the best ways to edit and share photos both digitally and in print.

Prerequisite: Intro to Digital Photography or instructor approval.

Tuition is \$50 for non-members and \$40 for current CAC members. Students must bring their own digital cameras. This class focuses on DSLR cameras, all brands welcomed.

#### Ceramic Mug Workshop with Maureen Duffy-Daugavietis

This 1-day workshop will meet on Friday, December 9 at 6-8 PM.

Grab your bestie, partner, sibling, or come meet new people during this fun evening of creating! With guidance from Maureen Duffy-Daugavietis, students will construct a hand-built mug using the slab process and various decorative techniques to make each student's mug uniquely their own. Students will select a glaze color, and the Center will complete glazing & firing.

Tuition is \$50.00 for nonmembers and \$40.00 for current CAC members. All materials are provided, including glazing & firing.

#### Bookbinding with Terrence Chouinard

This 1-day workshop will meet on Saturday, December 10 at 10 AM-1 PM and is recommended for teens and adults, ages 16+.

A folded piece of paper makes a "folio." One folio inside another makes a "signature." One or multiple signatures sewn together make a "book".

With instruction from Terrence Chouinard, this workshop will cover basic bookbinding terms and tools with ample time allowed for hands-on practice. Students will construct a single signature/pamphlet binding with cover variations. This workshop will lay the conceptual and practical foundation for more advanced bookbinding skills. This class is held in the upstairs classroom.

Tuition is \$70 for non-members and \$60 for current CAC members. (A \$10 supply fee is due to the instructor at the beginning of class.)
