# Youth Arts Outreach - We're Expanding in 2024!



In November, CAC's 25-week Youth Arts Outreach Program in partnership with the Duneland Boys & Girls Club and the Duneland Family YMCA finished the second 5-week session that highlighted the topic "Makers and Media". With guidance from CAC instructor Emily Blossom, students experimented with a variety of media including watercolor, pastel, sculpture, and collage as they created projects inspired by famous artists including Yayoi Kusama, Louise Nevelson, and Hannah Höch. In January, we are excited to launch the expansion of the Youth Arts Outreach Program as we will continue to serve Boys & Girls Club and now concurrently serve all five YMCA elementary after school sites, allowing us to serve up to 170 kids per 5-week session.

The Youth Arts Outreach Program supports CAC's mission of creating accessible, enriching arts programming for our community and is generously funded by Cleveland-Cliffs Foundation.

# **TAG!** Teen Arts Group

This past month, Teen Arts Group members participated in a group critique where they shared their art, asked questions about each other's work, and discussed their unique perspectives as artists. Members then worked on a special "create-it-forward" project where each artist designed a unique postcard.

This month, TAG members will enjoy a special workshop with local artist Suzy Vance as they learn all about the process of making handmade paper.

CAC's Teen Arts Group (TAG) is a free monthly program for passionate teen artists interested in pursuing professional arts experiences and strengthening their own visual art practices. # Youth Programs/December



# After School Art Printmaking

The December sessions of After School Art are instructed by Jen Aitchison and will focus on printmaking! With inspiration from famous Japanese printmakers like Hokusai and Hiroshige, students will learn the process of printmaking and how to create an edition of 'prints' as they experiment with ink and paper variations. Each student will create a whimsical winter scene to celebrate the season.

After School Art classes are offered every month from September-May for ages 5-16. During each 4-class monthly session, students will explore an arts-related topic, movement, or technique through a variety of 2D media such as watercolor, pastel, graphite, acrylic, or printmaking.

# After School Sculpture 3D Winter Village

The December session of After School Sculpture is instructed by Emily Blossom and will focus on 3D construction using recycled and sculptural materials including cardboard, paper mache, and modeling clay. Students will work to construct a winter village filled with snowy trees, cozy cottages, and other unique details that bring their winter wonderland to life!

After School Sculpture class is offered every month from September-May for ages 8-12. During each 4-class monthly session, students will explore an arts-related topic, movement, or technique through a variety of 3D media such as clay, plaster, paper mache, or mixed materials.

#### Specialty Classes Ceramic Holiday Dish Workshop \*SOLD OUT\* Ages 12-18 / Friday, December 1

from 6-8 PM

This workshop invites families to join us for a fun evening of creating together! With guidance from Emily Casella, each family will construct a medium-sized dish, commonly nicknamed a "poof plate", using the slab process and various decorative techniques. Families will be encouraged to work together to add textures and additional details to create the perfect cookie dish for Santa and/or other holiday treats. Students will apply glaze, and the Center will complete firing.

Tuition is \$15/person. *Please note: Every attending child and adult needs to have their own individual ticket.* 

#### Family Ceramic Menorah Workshop

Families, ages 5+ / Saturday, December 2 from 10 AM-12 PM

This workshop invites families to join us for a fun morning of creating together! With guidance from Jillian Bridgeman, each family will construct a simple ceramic menorah using the slab process and various decorative techniques. Texture tools, stamps, and shape cutters will be available so families can personalize this sentimental piece for their Hanukkah celebration. Pieces will be made from a speckled clay that is unglazed, and the Center will complete firing.

Tuition is \$15/person. Please note: Every attending child and adult needs to have their own individual ticket.

# **Adult Art Classes**

Our classes provide a creative space for artists to learn at every age and level.

#### Mixed Media Drawing Workshop 1-day workshop / Saturda

1-day workshop / Saturday, December 2 from 10 AM-1 PM

With guidance from Diana Stezalski, students will explore the vast possibilities of drawing media and learn how to create dynamic art that utilizes a mixture of materials. Students will experiment with graphite, charcoal, colored pencil, pastel, chalk, ink, and additional additive media as they work to create an exploratory mixed media accordion book whereby each page addresses a different media, surface, or style. Fundamental skills on color theory, composition, value, and texture will be addressed. This class is held in the upstairs classroom.

Tuition is \$85 for non-members / \$76.50 for current CAC members, supplies included

#### **Basket Weaving 101**

3-class session / Wednesday, December 6-20 from 6-9 PM

With guidance from Cheryl Cavlovic, students will learn about the history and practice of basket weaving, from its early beginnings to its evolution in cultures across the globe. Basic weaving techniques will be taught as students construct a hand-woven D-handle market basket made from reed and wicker. The introductory skills from this class will inspire future projects as students gain confidence in their weaving practice. This class is held in the upstairs classroom.

Tuition is \$110 for non-members / \$99 for current CAC members + \$25 supply fee

#### Garland Printing Workshop 1-day workshop / Friday, December 8 from 6:30-8:30 PM

With guidance from Georgia Geis, students will explore the basics of block printing as they create a hand-printed winter garland. Each student will learn to carve their own festive linocut stamp, print onto tissue paper, and then string their prints together. To allow for more pattern options, the class will be encouraged to share stamps and collaborate! Linocut stamps can then be used for all of your decorating needs this holiday season. This class is held in the downstairs classroom.

Tuition is \$70 for non-members / \$63 for current CAC members, supplies included

Paper Marbling Workshop 1-day workshop / Saturday, December 9 from 10 AM-12 PM

With guidance from Diana Stezalski, students will explore the art of paper marbling, an ancient Japanese practice known as "suminagashi" or "floating ink". Working with a small tray, students will create unique marbled patterns on the surface of water using a variety of colorful inks. Students will then lightly submerge their paper into the tray to transfer the design, resulting in a beautifully dyed paper. Papers will be left at the Center to dry and can be picked up at a later date. This class is held in the upstairs classroom.

Holiday Watercolor Workshop - December 9th

#### Holiday Watercolor Workshop 1-day workshop / Saturday, December 9 from 10 AM-12 PM

'Tis the season to hone your watercolor skills! With guidance from Nora Block, students will learn introductory painting techniques, discuss watercolor supplies, and gain a stronger understanding of composition so they can become a more confident painter. Students will apply their newfound skills as they create hand-painted holiday cards and gift tags filled with festive imagery like evergreen trees, ornaments, and winter wreaths. This class is held in the downstairs classroom.
