A Color and Black & White Photography Show

The Chesterton Art Center is proud to sponsor this color and black & white photography show and competition. The purpose of this show is two-fold: 1). to strengthen the development of individual artists, and 2). to stimulate and expand audiences for the arts in the region.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The competition is open to all photographers 18 years of age or older residing in Indiana, Illinois and Michigan. Each entry must be original in concept and the work of the photographer. No copies or reproductions will be allowed. This includes copies of other artist's work or work done from published photos. All photographs must be the artists' own work.

Cost of participation is \$30.00 for either one or two entries. Entry fee may be paid with cash, check, debit or credit and must be paid at time of delivery.

Photographs must be matted, framed, and have a wire for hanging. (No sawtooth hangers)

You may enter up to two photographs, either color and/or black and white.

EXHIBITION RULES

-Any photographic process or work dependent primarily on photographic process is acceptable.

-Framed piece must not exceed 20" x 24"

-The unmatted portion of the print shall not be less than 8" x 10". Mats should be neutral in color, such as white, beige or gray. **No colored mats, please.**

-All prints must be made from negatives, transparencies, or digital images exposed after January 2014.

Entries may be brought to the Chesterton Art Center on the following days:

Monday, February 27 and Tuesday, February 28 from 11 am - 4.

Exhibition dates: March 5 through March 29.

Opening Reception and Awards: Sunday, March 5, 2-4 pm.

Pick-up of work: March 30, 31, & Saturday, April 1

EXHIBIT HOURS

The Chesterton Art Center is open weekdays from 11 am to 4 pm, and Saturdays 10 am to 2 pm.

SALES AND LIABILITY

Should you choose to sell your work, the AACPC will retain a 30% (20% for AACPC members) commission on any work sold from the show. Sale price should include this commission.

The Chesterton Art Center assumes no liability for works that are damaged, lost, or stolen during the time it is housed at the Chesterton Art Center. Your signature on the entry form means that you understand and will abide by these policies.

RETURN OF ENTRIES

All work must be picked up by April 15. Unclaimed work becomes the property of the AACPC.

AWARDS

Cash awards will be presented at the opening reception on Sunday, March 5 at 3 p.m.
