September 9 through October 3, 2018

The Chesterton Art Center, operated by the Association of Artists and Craftsmen of Porter County, is proud to sponsor **ART COMP 2018**, a biennial juried competition.

The purpose of this exhibition: 1) to strengthen the development of individual artists, and 2) to stimulate and expand the audience for arts in the region.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This competition is open to all artists over 18 years old residing in Indiana, Illinois, and Michigan.

ENTRY FEES

The non-refundable entry fee of \$25 for CAC members, and \$30 for non-members entitles each artist to submit up to two entries. Make checks payable to the **Chesterton Art Center**.

All 2-D and 3-D fine art media are accepted (e.g. sculpture, glass work, oil, acrylic, watercolor, mixed media, photography, pastel, and drawing. No vector computer art or crafts. All work that will hang on the wall must be fitted with wire. No sawtooth hangers. Sculpture must have an adequate base.

Work must be original in concept and execution, created within the past two years, not completed under instruction, and not previously exhibited at the Chesterton Art Center. No copies or prints of paintings, published photographs or other artist's work will be accepted. No wet paintings.

Maximum size for two dimensional work is 4 feet in any direction. Three dimensional work must not weigh more than 100 pounds. All entries must be ready for installation and must not require the artist's presence for handling. Jurors are Lora Fosberg, Exhibition Director; Lubeznik Center for the Arts, and Gregg Hertzlieb, Director and Curator of the Brauer Museum of Art.

Hand-deliver entries to the Chesterton Art Center September 1, 4, & 5th 2018, special hours stated on previous page. All works not selected for the exhibit must be picked up Saturday, September 8 from 10 am until 2 pm. Work included in the show must remain up through the end of the show - no early withdrawals. All work selected for the exhibit must be picked up October 4th through 6th during regular business hours.

The AACPC will not be responsible for damage, theft, or loss of artwork after delivery for inclusion in the show. Work not retrieved within 30 days after the final pick up date is considered abandoned property and ownership reverts to the Chesterton Art Center.
