Students applying for the scholarship will need to submit the following:

1. A portfolio of your work; include both two and three dimensional pieces. Two-dimensional work should be matted. No more than 3 pieces, please.
2. Your sketchbooks or art journals.

Interested seniors may contact the Chesterton Art Center for further information. The portfolio must be received at the Chesterton Art Center by Friday, April 12th. Winner will be notified by April 19. Work can be picked up after Friday, April 19.
